



why is it so hard to spell English words?

English consists of originally English words, but it also collected words from other languages and made them part of the English lexicon. With 26 letters and about 44 letter sounds, English is a hodgepodge of letters and sounds that don't always line up. Take the letter 'x,' for example, found in the words "extra," "mix," and "example," or the vowel sound in "weigh" and "way"!







In 1925, the first national spelling bee was organized by the Louisville Courier-Journal with a total of nine spellers. Frank Neuhauser won the championship title after correctly spelling "gladiolus."







The Bee doesn't include words labeled obsolete or archaic in competition lists, and you won't find any in 2024 Words of the Champions either. Why? Because they're just not used that often. Words labeled obsolete are found in literature but have not been part of standard English since 1755; words labeled archaic are only used rarely or in special contexts such as prayers or poetry since 1755. Why 1755? That was the year that the first really large and comprehensive dictionary was published in London by Samuel Johnson.



A root can be a simple stand-alone word all by itself (like Greek *para* meaning "alongside") or a root can also be a word's core piece having a clearly identifiable meaning that, with the help of a suffix or prefix, makes a stand-alone word. Think about Dev Shah's 2023 winning word: "psammophile". The first part of this word contains the Greek root *psamm*-meaning "sand." The second part of Dev's word contains the Greek root *-phil* from the Greek word philos meaning "beloved, dear, loving." Put that together and... can you guess what the word means?

consonants 101

Not sure whether the word has one consonant or two? Check to see if the word has a suffix, such as a verb that has been conjugated. These words often - but not always! - have a doubled consonant before that suffix. "The speckled frog *hopped* off the log while the horse *plodded* down the lane and the train *chugged* down the tracks." In each of these cases, the vowel before the doubled letter is a short sound. Can you spot others like this, and some that have long vowel sounds and do not double that consonant?

all about the schwa

Be like a schwa – never stressed! Except that when you're a speller, a schwa can really stress you out! Why? A schwa is pronounced "uh" and in spelling can be any vowel: a, e, i, o, u or y. That can make a word pretty tough to spell. If you ask for the word's language of origin, you can try using that to help you out. If your word is from Greek, you might want to try an 'o' for that schwa, like in "bacteriolytic"!


